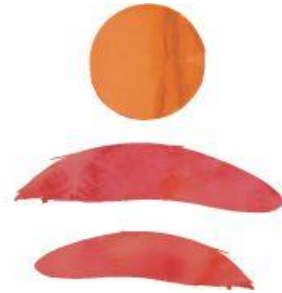

The National Association of Disability Practitioners Statement on Early Vaccination for Covid-19

The National Association of Disability Practitioners recognises that a limited number of members of the National Association for Disability Practitioners should be counted as critical workers under the Children of Critical Workers Guidance.

These are members who are specialist education professionals who must remain active in a face-to-face role in order to support students.

Furthermore, these practitioners would also qualify under the social care guidelines to be vaccinated with priority group 2, as they are involved directly in delivering social care such that they and vulnerable students are at increased risk of exposure due to close working proximity.

We advise members who believe that they qualify as a Disability/Inclusivity Practitioner who requires an early vaccination within these guidelines to contact their host institution for support on how to do this.
